### **Sorna Introduces Windows®-based Software to Transfer DICOM Images to Apple iPod®**

**Eagan, MN - November 26, 2006** -- Sorna Corporation (Booth #1501 South Hall) is demonstrating the ability to transfer diagnostic images and reports to an Apple iPod® from a personal computer running Windows® XP using Sorna's new Reviewer™ software. The Reviewer software, making its debut at RSNA 2006, is designed to simplify the process of importing diagnostic images and reports from DICOM CDs and DVDs or any other DICOM source.

Sorna's Reviewer communicates with any DICOM storage device as well as DICOM CD/DVD burners, networked drives, memory sticks, and now the Apple iPod. The Reviewer has the ability to write both JPEG and DICOM files of diagnostic images, 3D visualizations, reports and other medical data to an Apple iPod. The users then have the option to transfer the data to another DICOM device, or to synchronize it with their iTunes® media library.
